- Prepare to listen
- Present positive body language
- Focus on content, not delivery
- Focus on the main points
- Suspend judgment
- Finish listening
- Ask questions for **clarification**
- Encourage the speaker to expound
- **Acknowledge** emotional content
- Mirror the message
