

International Organization for Standardization (ISO) is the world's largest standards-developing organization. ISO is a non-governmental organization that bridges communication between the public and private business sectors. Many ISO member organizations are part of the governmental structure of their countries or are mandated by their governments. Other members belong to the private sector and are set up by industry association national partnerships.

ISO is a network of the national standards institutes of 163 countries, with one member per country. The Central Secretariat in Geneva, Switzerland, serves to coordinate the system.
